When the year 2020 started, as an API Associate I had high hopes to reach many church leaders with Biblical Counseling. But after Covid and lockdowns installed in different parts of Kenya and beyond our borders, I thought all was lost. But The Lord was so faithful as technology, via Zoom, came in effectively.

So far we are able to meet weekly for biblical counseling with Jay Mcbee and Craig Black. They have made a huge impact by showing us how Biblical Counseling is so effective.
